- Health Quality Ontario: MyPractice Reports – This primary care report can help you focus your quality improvement efforts
- Quality Standards: in collaboration with clinical experts, patients and caregivers across the province have introduced Quality Standards for a number of conditions
- eConsult: Service allows you to consult with specialists across the province so you get the best care possible for your patients
- Centre for Effective Practice – Academic detailing for opioid prescribing (MainPro accredited)
- Bounce Back: A free skill-building program designed to help adults and youth manage symptoms of depression and anxiety
