## What's happening in primary care?

#### 1. Interprofessional Primary Care Team Expansion Update

The 2017 Ontario budget included a major investment in team-based primary care to create new or expand existing interprofessional care teams so that all 76 sub-regions across the province have a team. The Mississauga Halton LHIN endorsed several business cases for the expansion of primary care services in the region and received funding to create and expand primary care teams in Mississauga.

- eConsult: Service allows you to consult with specialists across the province so you get the best care possible for your patients
- Centre for Effective Practice Academic detailing for opioid prescribing (MainPro accredited)
- Bounce Back: A free skill-building program designed to help adults and youth manage symptoms of depression and anxiety
