

The Ontario eConsult Program

Options for Mississauga Halton LHIN Providers – April 2019

eConsult is a secure web-based tool that allows physicians and nurse practitioners timely access to specialist advice for patients and often eliminates the need for an in-person specialist visit.

Providers in the Mississauga Halton LHIN can access eConsult through either the regional Champlain BASE™ eConsult or the province-wide Ontario eConsult provincial service.

Why do both services exist here?

- Mississauga Halton LHIN participated in the provincial pilot of eConsult in 2014 in the Champlain BASE™ eConsult platform, where specialists were recruited to provide eConsults in addition to the specialties already available on the platform (14 local and 46 provincial)
- Evaluation of the pilot in your region was positive with 609 eConsults completed
- The province has since funded and implemented provincial wide service on the OTNhub in addition to Champlain BASE™ eConsult

Champlain BASE™ eConsult

- Regional service for Champlain LHIN and Mississauga Halton LHIN
- Local specialists and PCPs
- Hosted on SharePoint platform
- Access specialists through specialty groups
- More than 120 BASE™ managed specialty groups with specialists from the Mississauga Halton LHIN and Champlain LHIN regions

Ontario eConsult Service

- Province-wide eConsult Service
- Specialists and PCPs from across the province
- Hosted on the OTNhub
- Access specialists through specialty groups or directly by name
- More than 80 BASE™ managed specialty groups with specialists from across the province

Regional service hosted on SharePoint platform

How to sign up

- Brief registration by contacting econsultsupport@lhinworks.on.ca directly or a Primary Care Advisor from the Mississauga Halton LHIN who can assist you in registration
- Credentials are established by the appropriate organization (e.g., the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario for family physicians, the Nurse Practitioners' Association of Ontario for nurse practitioners)
- Review a participant consent document and confirm their agreement to join the service
- Complete a 30-minute training session delivered by telephone, where an experienced trainer orients them to the service.
 - Face-to-face training can be organized for those who prefer.
 - Written training documents are available outlining the steps required to initiate and complete an eConsult case.

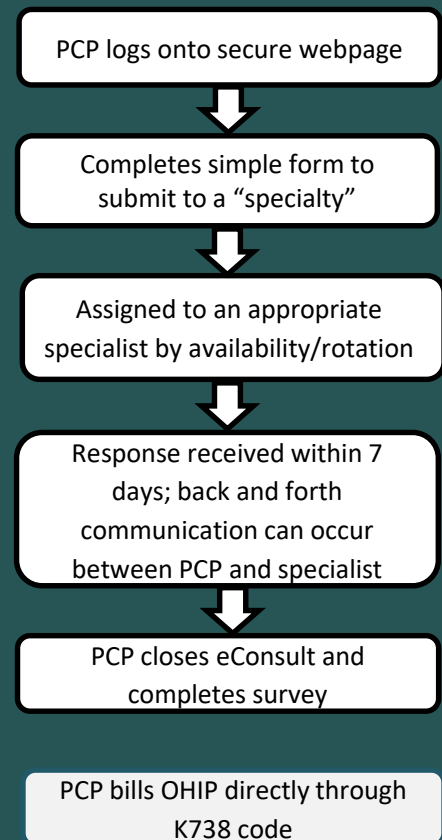

How to sign-up

- If you have an existing OTNhub account, you may already have access to eConsult. If you do not have an OTNhub account, you require a OneID to gain access to the OTNhub.
- If you do not have an existing OneID, please sign up for one through the CPSO website (<https://www.cpso.on.ca/MembersFolder/eHealth-ONEID?feed=5e3a6a4a-aa93-4aed-abaa-0d2ba1feb9bd>). Ensure you are signed into the CPSO website first.
- Once you have a OneID, you can register for the OTNhub by clicking the following links as either a Solo Provider (<https://signup.otn.ca/individual-signup/>) or affiliated with your organization (<https://signup.otn.ca/org-signup/>).
